- 17-24 1s dance under arch made by 2s, 2s dance under arch made by 1s; & rp
- 25-32 1s+2s Poussette

- 1-8 1M+2L Turn 2H; 1L+2M Turn 2H, #8, 1s, 2s+3s dance in ...
- 9-16 1s+2s+3s 3C Promenade
- 17-24 1s Cross RH, Cast 1 pl; Cross up btn 2s, Cast to 2<sup>nd</sup> pl (2s up #23-24)
- 25-32 Circle 6H round & back
- 04 <u>CIRCASSIAN CIRCLE</u> in 2s, lady on prtnr's right Collins Pocket Ref. (may be regional variations)
- 1-8 All Adv+Ret twice
  9-16 All Ladies Adv, Clap, Ret

All Men Adv, Clap & pull LSh back to face new prtnr on his left

- 17-24 All Set twice to new prtnr; Turn RH, end facing cc'w
- 25-32 All Promenade cc'w, end in lg circle, lady on prtnr's right, all facing in, ready to rp

- RSCDS Golden Jubilee Leaflet
  1-8 1M Cast 1 pl as 2M step up, 1M+3L Set; 1M+3L Turn RH
- 9-16 1L Cast 1 pl as 2L step up, 1L+3M Set; 1L+3M Turn LH
- 17-24 RHA: 1L+2s, 1M+3s, end 1s in ctr LHJ, 1s Set, Dance out to 2<sup>nd</sup> pl opp sides
- 25-32 RHA: 1M+2s, 1L+3s, end 1s in ctr LHJ, 1s Set, Dance out to 2<sup>nd</sup> pl own sides

Scottish country dance is the traditional social dance of Scotland. We dance lively jigs and reels and the stately, distinctively-Scottish Strathspey. Scottish country dance is great fun for young and old but it *IS* challenging, mentally and physically.

Classes run in two 10-week semesters: September and January. Cost is reasonable. You don't need a partner because we change partners every dance anyway. Not many activities combine such great exercise with a strong social aspect, and so much fun!
