## A 32-bar reel for three couples in a four-couple set

## Bars

1-2: 1st man and 2 nd woman cross giving right hand.
3-4: 1st woman and 2 nd man cross giving right hand.
5-6: 1st man and 3rd man cross giving right hand.
7-8: 1st woman and 3rd woman cross giving right hand.
9-16: 1st couple set, lead up to the top, cross and cast into second place.
3 rd couple step down on bars 15-16. (All are now on opposite sides in order 2, 1, 3)
17-24: 1 st couple dance reels of three across, 1 st man with 3 rd couple and 1 st woman with 2 nd couple.
25-28: 2nd, 1st and 3rd couples advance and retire.
29-32: $2 \mathrm{nd}, 1$ st and 3 rd couples turn by the right hand one and a half times.
Repeat from new places.
